TASKS

1. Trace out the $\frac{1}{2}$ scale skirt blocks size 16 provided and produce master grading for sizes 18 and 22.
2. (a) Trace size 16 and develop final patterns for the skirt style sketched below.
NB: Omit waistband.

Measurements:

Pocket depth = 30cm
Godet depth = 25cm
Godet width = 20cm

- (b) Trace the developed pattern for the skirt centre back panel and grade down to size 14.
