TASK

Using the bodice, sleeve blocks and the measurements provided, develop and produce final patterns for the blouse style sketched on page 2. (Front facing is separate).

Measurements

Full length	66cm
Sleeve length	54cm
Shoulder tab width	3cm
Pleat depth	2cm
Collar depth	9cm
