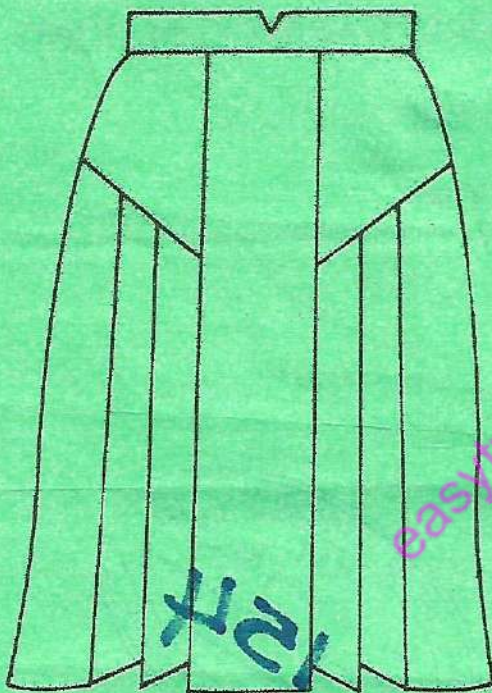
## TASK

Using the basic blocks and the measurements provided, develop and produce final patterns for the skirt style sketched below.

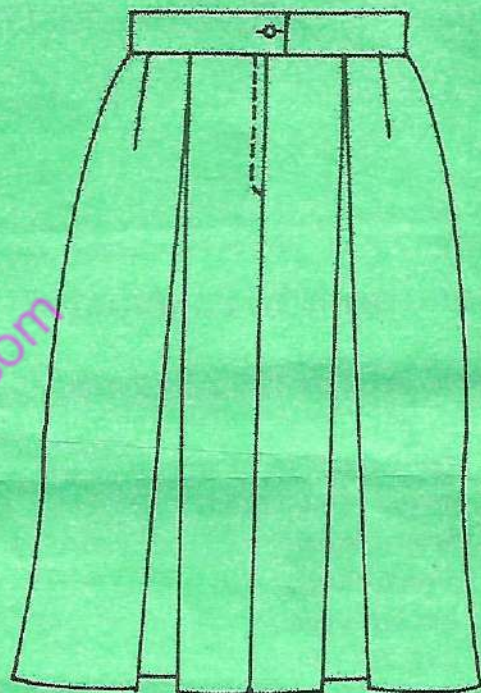
**Note:** Show all seam allowances.
