  - (viii) eraser;
  - (ix) paper scissors;
  - (x) tracing wheel;
  - (xi) sellotape/glue;
  - (xii) paper pins;
  - (xiii) tape measure.
  
2. All stages of pattern development must be clearly shown.

Candidates should check the question paper to ascertain that all the pages are printed as indicated and that no questions are missing.



## TASK

Using the casual shirt blocks, sleeve block and the measurements provided, develop and produce final patterns for the garment style sketched on page 3.

### NB:

- Omit **all** seam allowances.
- Add hem allowance to the sleeve **only**.

### Measurements:

Sleeve length	-	22 cm
Sleeve hem allowance	-	3 cm
Button stand	-	1.5 cm
Pleat depth	-	2 cm
Facing width	-	4 cm
Collar depth	-	3.5 cm
Neckline	-	29 cm
Pocket depth	-	11 cm
