 - (iii) sleeveless;
 - (iv) combined linked and layered tiers;
 - (v) contrasting plain and striped fabrics.

- (b) With the aid of two illustrations in each case, identify the two basic categories of shapes. (6 marks)
- (c) Outline four uses of a fashion figure. (4 marks)
3. (a) Explain the following product development activities:
- (i) replication; (2 marks)
 - (ii) sketching. (2 marks)
- (b) Outline four elements of art and design that are exposed on flat surfaces. (4 marks)
- (c) Sketch the following pocket types:
- (i) petal; (2 marks)
 - (ii) mechanic's; (2 marks)
 - (iii) bucket; (2 marks)
 - (iv) jetted with tab. (2 marks)
- (d) Identify four tie-dye techniques. (4 marks)

SECTION B: PATTERN DRAFTING I (60 marks)

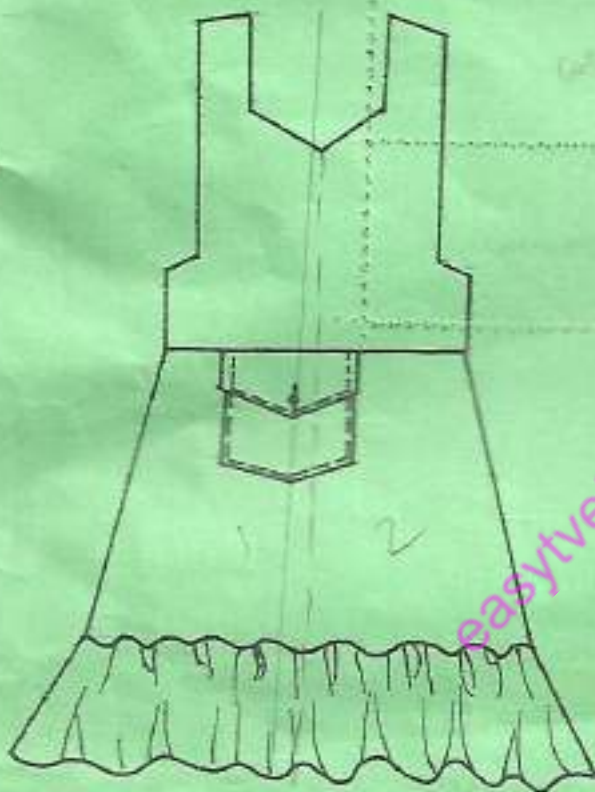

NB: Omit seam and hem allowances.



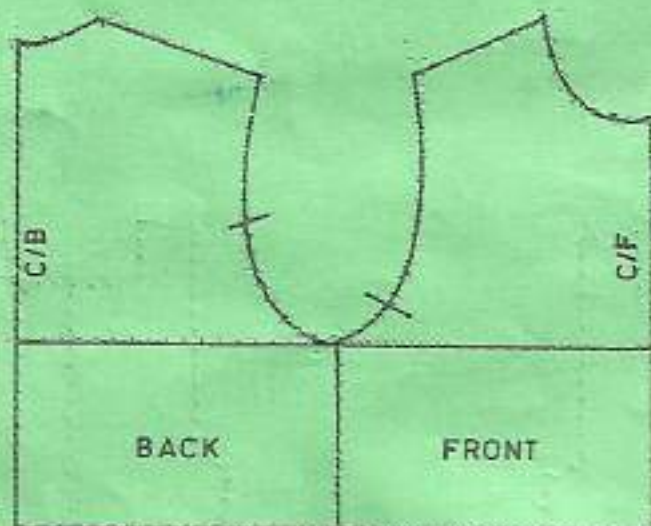
FRONT VIEW
