- (i) pencil; (2 marks)
 - (ii) peplum; (2 marks)
 - (iii) bubble; (2 marks)
 - (iv) mermaid. (2 marks)
- (c) Explain the following principles of organization in fashion design:
- (i) unity; (2 marks)
 - (ii) proportion; (2 marks)
 - (iii) emphasis. (2 marks)
2. (a) (i) Outline the advantages of quick sketching in painting. (4 marks)
- (ii) Identify four materials and tools contained in a sketching kit. (4 marks)
- (b) Sketch the front view of a casual blouse to show the following details:
- (i) roll up sleeves;
 - (ii) top stitched panel seams;
 - (iii) mandarin collar;
 - (iv) shaped yoke. (10 marks)
- (c) Outline two types of materials used in making printing blocks. (2 marks)

3. (a) Distinguish between the following:
- (i) fashion figure and fit model; (4 marks)
 - (ii) fashion design and art. (4 marks)
- (b) Sketch the front view of a tent dress to show the following details:
- (i) convertible collar;
 - (ii) long sleeves with frills;
 - (iii) slanted welt pockets;
 - (iv) button through opening;
 - (v) yoke with gathers.
- (10 marks)
- (c) Outline two categories of man made forms. (2 marks)

NB: Omit seam and hem allowances.



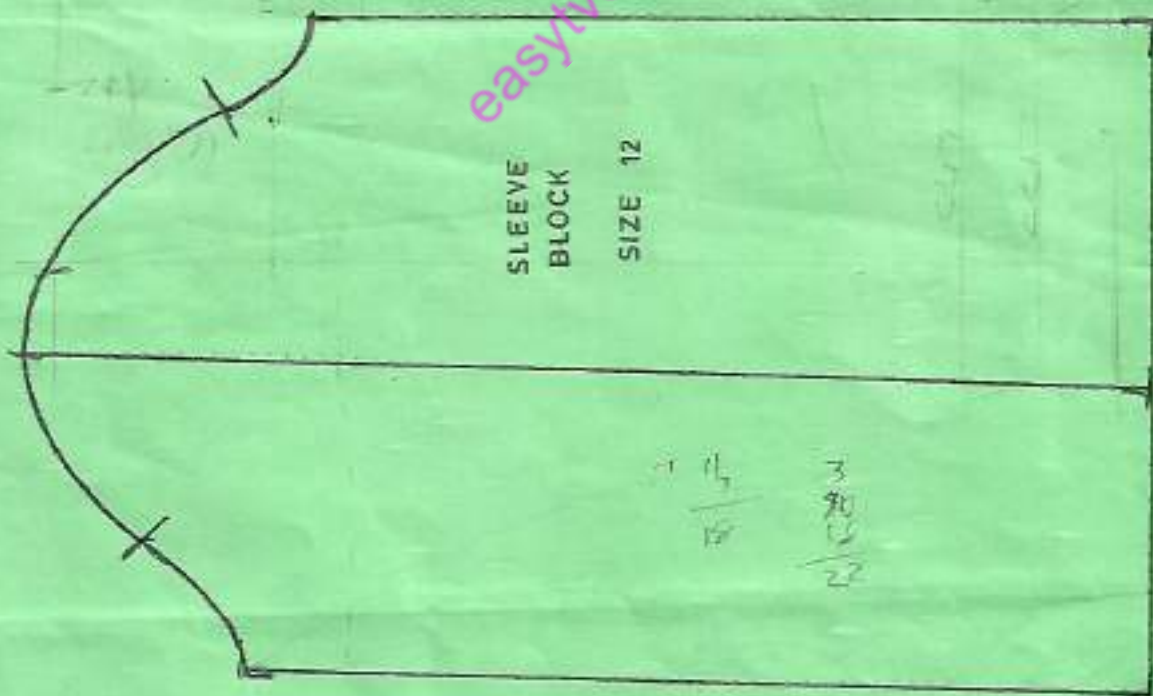
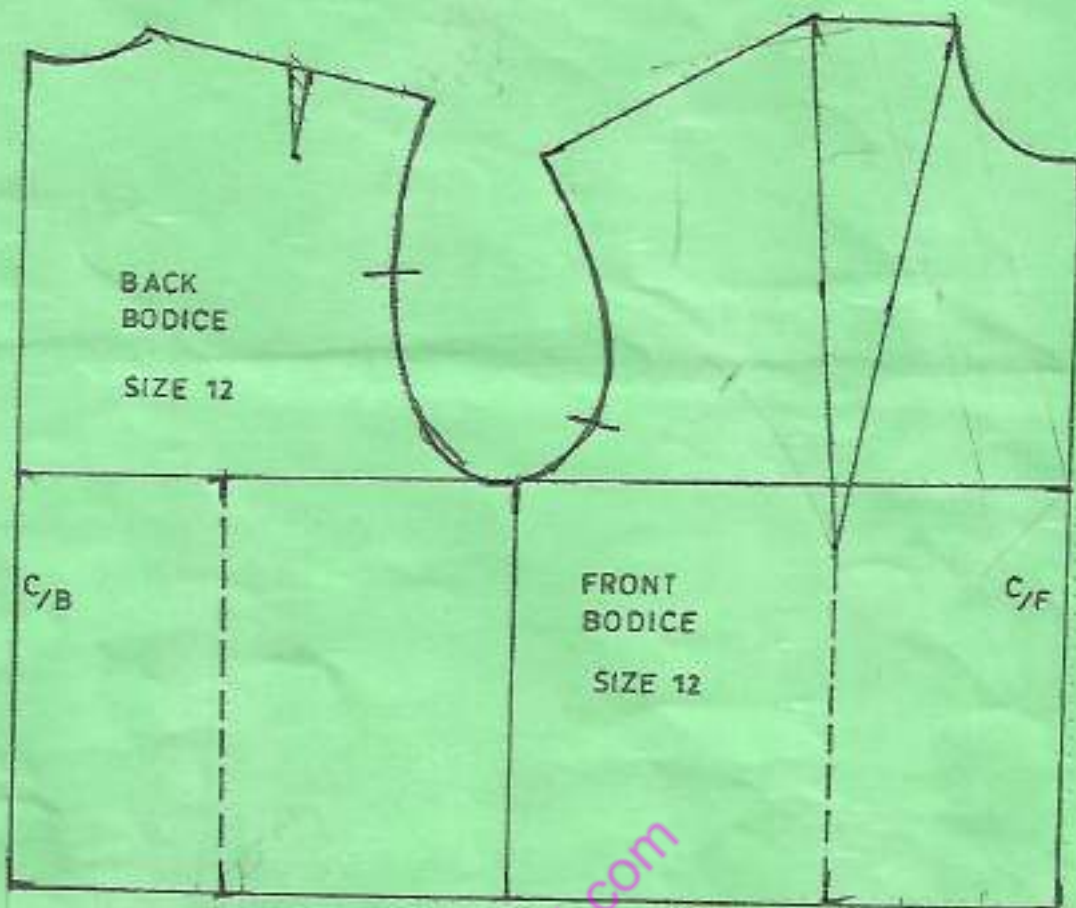
FRONT VIEW
