1. Cotton fabric (50 cm x 50 cm)
2. Small buckets
3. Stirring rods
4. Hot water
5. Chemical (caustic soda, sodium hydrosulphite)
6. Protective gear (gloves, nose masks, dust coat)
7. Cotton twine

## PRINTING REQUIREMENT

1. Stanley knife/surgical blade
2. Water -based printing paste
3. Cotton fabric (50 cm x 50 cm)

### SECTION A - TIE AND DYE (60 marks)

Fold the fabric provided diagonally five times to form a triangle.  
Use the spiral binding technique to tie and dye the fabric.

### SECTION B - PRINTING (40 marks)

Prepare a stencil with abstract shapes. Use the stencil and the printing paste to print the fabric provided.
