- Paraffin wax
- Sisal brush
- Steel pot/sufuria
- Old newspapers
- Iron
- Large sufuria
- Detergent
- Vat dyes (liquid/powder)
- Sodium hydrosulphite
- Sodium hydroxide (caustic soda)
- Stove/jiko

B: EMBROIDERY REQUIREMENTS

- Fabric (50 x 50 cm)
- Assorted colour embroidery thread
- Embroidery hoop/ring
- Sewing machine (straight-stitching)
- Dressmaker's carbon paper
- Tracing wheel

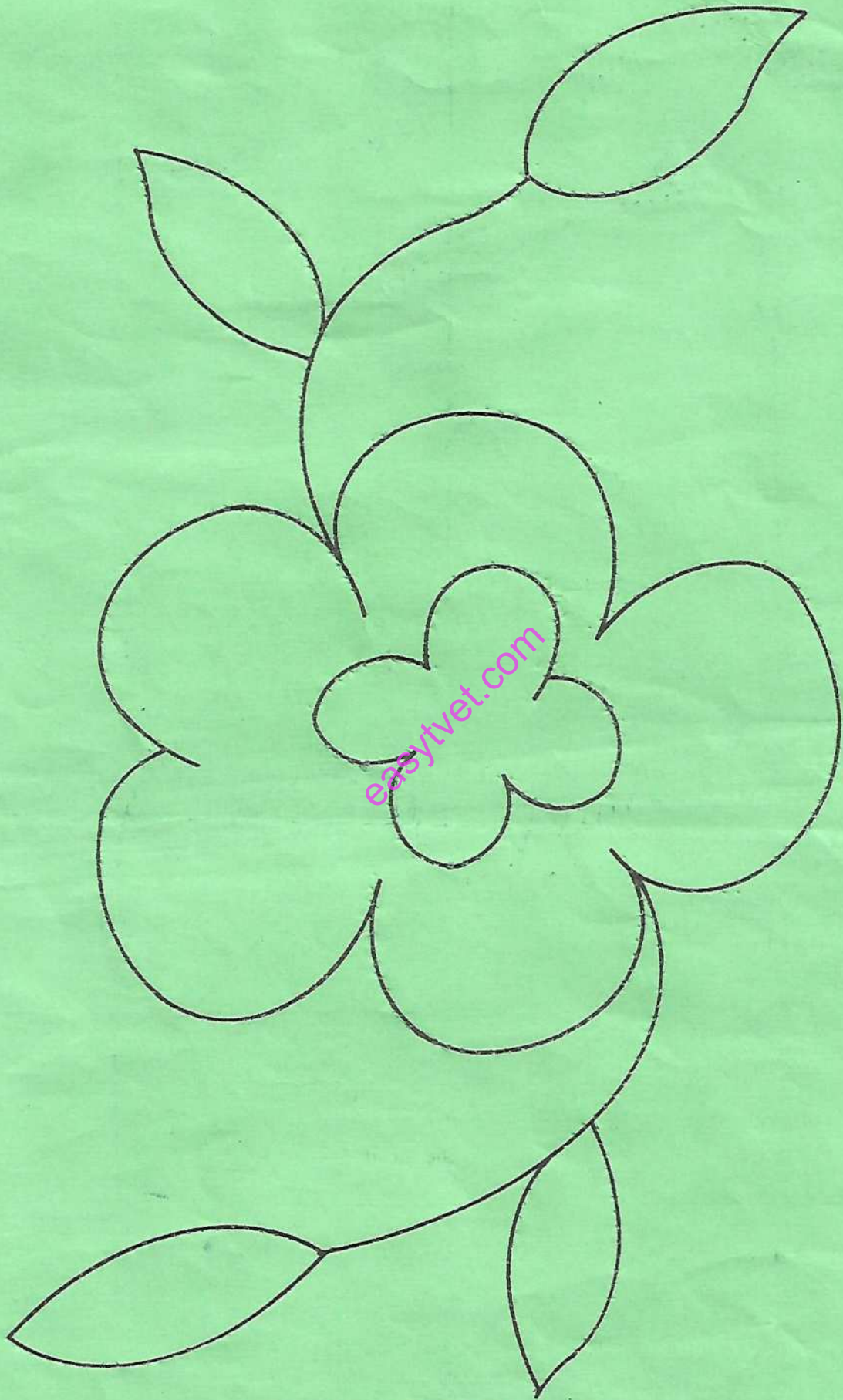
TASKS

Trace out the motif provided and produce an embroidered fabric using the straight stitching technique for outlining and filling-in the motif.
