INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

1. You should have the following for this examination:
 - (a) plain medium weight fabric $1 \frac{1}{2}$ metres long by 152 cm wide.
 - (b) 'flat' shirt and sleeve block for age 11 (boys) in full scale.
 - (c) adhesive interfacing 85 cm by 50 cm.
 - (d) one button 1.5 cm diameter without shank.
 - (e) sewing thread to match the fabric.
 - (f) brown papers.
 - (g) sewing tools.
 - (h) one large envelope.

2. At the end of the examination:
 - (a) Stitch on a label bearing your name and index number on a single layer of fabric without concealing any detail.
 - (b) Enclose the garment in the large envelope.

This paper consists of 2 printed pages.

Candidates should check the question paper to ascertain that both pages are printed as indicated and that no questions are missing.

TASKS

Using the 'flat' shirt and sleeve blocks and the measurements provided, produce final patterns for the dust coat style below.

NB: Spend minimal time on preparation of patterns.

Using the materials and the prepared patterns, cut out and make the garment as follows:

- Use plain closed seams at the shoulders, sides and sleeve back seam.
- Top stitch the seams.
- Make one hand worked buttonhole at the break point and sew on the button.
- Slip hem the garment.

Full length	-	70 cm
Sleeve length	-	49 cm

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
