 - (v) narrow elastic 27 cm long;
 - (vi) hook and eye;
 - (vii) sewing tools;
 - (viii) brown papers;
 - (ix) one large envelope.
- At the end of the examination, stitch on a label bearing your name and index number on a single layer of fabric and enclose the garment in the large envelope.

Candidates should check the question paper to ascertain that all the pages are printed as indicated and that no questions are missing.

TASK

Using the measurements and the materials provided, cut out and make the garment sketched on page 3 as follows:

- (a) use plain open seams;
- (b) understitch the front facings;
- (c) make a double front peplum;
- (d) bind the sleeve hem;
- (e) make one hand worked buttonhole at the neckline and stitch on the button;
- (f) attach the hook and the eye at the waistline.
