- (vi) one large envelope;
- (vii) sewing tools;
- (viii) zip 18 cm (7") long.

## At the end of the examination:

- (a) stick on a label bearing your name and index number on a single layer of fabric without concealing any details;
- (b) enclose the garment in the large envelope provided.

## TASKS

- 1. Using the measurements and the materials provided, cut out and make the garment as follows:
  - (i) use plain closed seams at the sides, shoulders and underarms;
  - (ii) sandwich the front bodice and skirt into the midriff;
  - (iii) make one hand worked buttonhole and sew on the button at the top of the opening.
