 - (v) one button 1.5 cm diameter without a shank;
 - (vi) brown papers;
 - (vii) sewing tools;
 - (viii) one large envelope.
- 2. Study the sketches carefully before beginning the test.
- 3. At the end of the examination:
 - (a) stitch on a label bearing your name and index number on a single layer of fabric without concealing any details;
 - (b) enclose the garment in the large envelope provided.



TASKS

Using the measurements and the materials provided, cut out and make the dress style sketched below as follows:

- (a) use the plain open seam at the sides and shoulders;

- (d) use the extended facing at the front:
- (e) hand hem the garment;
- (f) make one hand worked buttonhole at the top of the opening and sew on the button.
