INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

1. *You should have the following items for this examination:*

- (i) *plain light weight fabric 2 metres long by 114 cm wide;*
- (ii) *fusible interfacing 26 cm by 40 cm;*
- (iii) *zip 33 cm (13") long;*
- (iv) *lining fabric to match the fabric ($\frac{1}{4}$ metre long by 114 cm wide);*
- (v) *ribbon 2 metres long;*
- (vi) *thread to match the fabric;*
- (vii) *sewing tools;*
- (viii) *brown papers;*
- (ix) *one large envelope.*

2. *At the end of the examination:*

- (a) *stitch on a label bearing your name and index number on a single layer of fabric without concealing any details;*
- (b) *enclose the garment in the large envelope provided and hand it over to the examiner.*

This paper consists of 2 printed pages.

Candidates should check the question paper to ascertain that both pages are printed as indicated and that no questions are missing.

TASKS

1. Using the measurements and the materials provided, cut out and make the girl's dress style sketched below as follows:
 - (i) use French seams at the shoulders and the sides;
 - (ii) finish the tier hem with ribbon;
 - (iii) fix the collar using a crossway strip;
 - (iv) finish the armholes with facings and under stitch.



Measurements

Bust	-	64 cm	- 25''
Waist	-	60 cm	- 23.5''
Hips	-	66 cm	- 26
Across back	-	26.6 cm	- 10.5
Neck size	-	29 cm	- 11
Shoulder	-	9.5 cm	- 3 3/4
Back neck to waist	-	28 cm	- 11
Full length	-	70 cm	- 27.5

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
